As a valued volunteer of the American Red Cross, you will be required to train in the following areas:

1. Introduction to Disasters.
2. Fulfilling Our Mission
3. Community Services Overview/Mass Care
4. Client Casework: Emergency Services to Families
5. Disaster Assessment
6. Shelter Operations
7. Shelter Simulation (Optional)

### **Completing Your First Training**

This is the “**Introduction To Disasters**” workshop and is self taught. (Be sure your computer’s volume is up).
